Health education that gives information on refusal skills, healthy relationships, STD's, contraceptive failure rates and poverty prevention through delay of childbearing until marriage.
Article 1, Section 27 of the Florida Constitution which defines marriage as between one man and one woman should be enforced as the legal definition for marriage in Florida.
Ordinances and/or policy that require private businesses, organizations, churches, schools, and/or synagogues to allow individuals to use the bathroom of the gender they self identify with.
Zoning laws to restrict church or religious meetings, including home Bible studies, from residential or commercial areas.
Require businesses to provide services for homosexual weddings even if their religious beliefs oppose homosexual marriage.
Faith-based Programs in the Criminal Justice System to combat drug abuse and reduce crime.
Allow law abiding citizens to own and/or carry a firearm within the city/county for protection.
Prohibit anyone who is not an American Citizen from registering to vote.
